Know All Men by These Presents:

That we, Walter W. Goldsmith and Henry P. Willimon, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ---Ten and 00/100---DOLLARS, and other valuable considerations to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Real Estate Fund, Inc., its successors and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the west side of Guess Street, and having, according to a plat of Mills Mill, made by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated September 1954, the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeast intersection of Guess Street and Deering Street and running along the north side of Deering Street S. 89-24 W. 50.5 feet to an iron pin 7.5 feet from the center line of the Mills Mill Southern Railway Spur Track; thence parallel to and 7.5 feet from the center line of said spur track N. 12-17 W. 439.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along the toe of a fill and said spur track N. 80-07 W. 92.8 feet; thence N. 80-38 E. 17.8 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Guess Street; thence along the west side of Guess Street S. 15-54 E. 255.2 feet and S. 14-10 E. 286.6 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is, subject to all easements and rights of way of record.

It is also subject to a protective covenant with respect to use of same in the deed of Mills Mill to the grantors herein, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Book of Deeds 509, at page 490. The Grantee, its successors and assigns, is hereby granted the same rights to use the Southern Railway-Mills Mill Spur Track as is set forth in said deed, but Grantors reserve the joint use of said track for the benefit of their property directly across said spur track and Grantors reserve for themselves, their heirs and assigns, the option granted in said deed to purchase said right of way in case the spur track is abandoned.



TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Incumbrances and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and its ~~heirs and assigns forever~~ successors and assigns, forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
