BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Scarlett Street, at joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30, and running thence with the line of said lot S. 57-48 E. 198.1 feet to iron pin; thence N. 32-42 E. 50 feet to iron pin; thence N. 49-11 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Scarlett Street; thence with Scarlett Street, S. 32-24 W. 80 feet to the point of beginning, and being identically the same property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed recorded in Deed Book 643, Page 542.
