

his heirs and assigns:
All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of lot #4, Thornwood Acres, property of Williams Land Company, according to plat prepared by Jones & Sutherland, Engineers, dated December 1958, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book MM, at Page 59, also shown on a later plat prepared by J. Mac Richardson and according to the later plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Thornwood Drive, joint corner of lots #4 and #5, and running with the joint line of said lots, N. 51-05 E. 103.7 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of lots #3, #4, and #5; and running thence along a new line through lot #4, N. 62-58 W. 118 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Edwards Road; running thence with the Eastern side of EdwardsRoad, S. 34-33 W. 36.5 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Edwards Road and Thornwood Drive, which intersection is curved, the chord of which is S. 0-03 E. 35.5 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Thornwood Drive; running thence with the Northern side of Thornwood Drive, S. 40-20 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.
