## Lot No. 6:

BEGINNING at a point in the new street line on the Northern side of Crescent Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 5 N. 1-0 E. 194.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-37 E. 85 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence with the line of Lot No. 7 S. 1-0 W. 193.1 feet to a point in the new street line of Crescent Avenue; thence with the new street line of Crescent Avenue S. 83-52 W. 85 feet to the point of beginning.

## ALSO:

ALL the right, title and interest of the Grantor herein in and to a ten (10) foot alley running from Jones Avenue in an Easterly direction along the rear line of Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, and approximately fifteen (15) feet of the Western side of the rear line of Lot No. 6.

The above described lots of land are the identical property conveyed to the grantor herein by Homozel M. Daniel by two deeds, each conveying an undivided one-half interest in the whole, the first of which is dated December 30, 1958 and the second, December 9, 1959, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, respectively, in Deed Book 650 at page 41 and in Deed Book 650 at page 44.

The premises hereinabove described are conveyed subject to restrictions appearing of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
