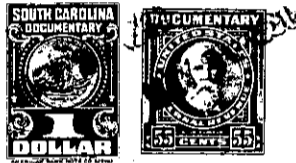
JOHN C. COTHRAN, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the Northeast side of Bleachery Road (formerly known as New Riverside Road), near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 5 on plat of the Hillhouse tract made by F. G. Rogers, Surveyor, 1908, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book A, Page 335, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Bleachery Road at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 6 N. 47-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the rear line of Lot No. 5, 67 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot A, S. 47-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Bleachery Road; thence along Bleachery Road in a Northwesterly direction 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of Marcelle Heath Sexton, dated November 4, 1955, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 540, page 7.
