Paul J. Oeland, Jr., his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 14 on plat of Wilton Oaks, said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BB, at page 49, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING AT AN IRON PIN ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF McNill Court at the northwest corner of Lot No. 15 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 15, S. 0-55 W. 164.9 feet to a pin; thence N. 79-15 W. 66 feet; thence N. 1-03 E. 149.4 feet with the line of Lot No. 13 to a pin on the south side of McNeill Court; thence with McNeill Court N. 84-35 E. 36.8 feet to a 'bend in said street; thence S. 89-05 E. 28.2 feet to the beginning corner.
