WHEREAS, I may become temporarily or permanently incapacitated and I desire to make provision against my possible inability to discharge my duties;

AND WHEREAS, I have the fullest confidence in my daughter, Anne Walker Asbury and her husband Wilburn Asbury, who are both acquainted with all my affairs, and I desire to give them full power and authority to act for me in the event I should become incapacitated:

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Margaret Moore Walker (Mrs. Hugh V.) do hereby make, constitute and appoint the above named Anne Walker Asbury and Wilburn Asbury, my true and lawful attorneys and trustees, for me, and in my name, place and stead, to make all arrangements and execute any contracts necessary or incident for the direction, conduct and management of my affairs, interests and my property in Greenville, South Carolina, or elsewhere, and to do any and all things, without limitation of their power, in their own judgment and discretion, without accountability to any person or persons for what they do. They shall have full power to act for me as they see fit at all times. This power shall include full authority to do anything whatsoever they may deem requisite and necessary to draw checks and make deposits. They shall act generally in these and all other matters for me, without limitation.
