It is agreed that time is of the essence of this contract, and if the said payments are not made when due the Owner shall be discharged in law and equity from all liability to make said deed, and may treat the Purchaser as a tenant holding over after the termination, or contrary to the terms of his lease, and shall be entitled to claim and recover, or retain if already paid the sum of **Five Hundred** (\$500) dollars per year for rent, or for liquidated damages, or may enforce payment of said note.

The Purchaser agrees to buy the land and pay for the same, subject to the above conditions.
