RIGHT OF WAY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Edwin Griffin and Sarah D. Griffin grantors, in consideration of \$ 100 paid by the Town of Simpsonville, a body politic under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Grantee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey unto the said grantee a right of way in and over our tract of land situate in the above State and County and deed to which is recorded in the office of the R.M.C. Office of said State and County in Book 602 at page 328, said lands being bounded by the lands of Hughes And Johnson and encroaching on our land a dis-975 feet, more or less, and being that portion of our said __feet wide, extending_____/\lambda/\nabla feet on each side of the center line as same has been marked out on the ground, and being shown on a print of file in the offices of the Town of Simpsonville and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. of the above said State and County in Plat Book MM at page / **b**0.

The expression or designation "Grantor" wherever used herein shall be understood to include the Mortgagee, if any there be.

2. This right of way is to and does convey to the grantee, its successors and assigns the following: The right and priviledge of entering the aforesaid strip of land, and to construct, maintain and operate within the limits of same, pipe lines, manholes, and any other adjuncts deemed by the grantee to be necessary for the purpose of conveying sanitary sewage and industrial wastes, and to make such relocations, changes, renewals, substitutions, replacements and additions of or to the same from time to time as said grantee may deem desirable; the right at all times to cut away and keep clear of said pipe lines any and all vegetation that might, in the opinion of the grantee, endanger or injure the pipe lines or their appurtenances, or interfere with their proper
