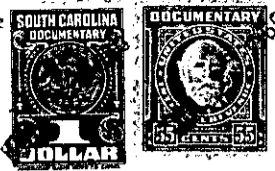

That I, Dewey F. Parker, Jr., in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Seventy Five and No/100 (\$175.00)----- DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged); have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Arthur N. Hewlett, his Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the South side of Pasadena Avenue, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 398 on plat of property known as Pleasant Valley made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book BB, page 163, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds; to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Pasadena Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots 397 and 398, and runs thence with the line of Lot 397, S. 0-08 E., 188.8 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Prosperity Avenue; thence along the northwest side of Prosperity Avenue N. 45-55 E., 83.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 399, N.0-08 W., 130.8 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Pasadena Avenue; thence along Pasadena Avenue, S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The above is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in Deed Book 638, Page 35.

As part of the consideration of this conveyance the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the mortgage given by the grantor to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., which mortgage is recorded in Mortgage Book , at Page , the balance now due and owing being \$9,185.86.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
