KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That The City of Greenville, a Municipal Corporation, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirty-Seven Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$3750.00) Dollars to the grantor in hand paid by the grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto R. E. Hughes, and his heirs and assigns forever:

"All that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being in the City of Greenville, situate on the western side of the new location of the Cleveland Street right-of-way, according to a survey made by J. W. Knight on April 23, 1959, and described as follows:
