KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Blake P. and David H. Garrett, in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars and the assumption of the Nine Thousand (\$9,000.00) Dollar mortgage hereinafter described, to the grantors in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantees (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wm. R. Timmons, Jr., as trustee for W. T. Patrick, John F. Chandler, Luther M. McBee, Wm. R. Timmons, Jr., his successors and assigns,:

All that lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Laurens, in Dials Township, in the Town of Fountain Inn, containing 51.45 acres more or less, according to plat of property of J. F. Hellams Estate, made by J. D.
