BEGINNING in the center of Brushy Creek and running thence N. 9-30 E., 370 feet to a pin; thence N. 78-40 W., 115 feet to a pin; thence N. 81-30 W., 295 feet to a pin; thence N. 73-40 W., 75 feet to a pin; thence S. 53-45 W., 120 feet to the center of said creek; thence along the center of said creek in an easterly direction 685 feet to the point of beginning.
