McAlister, his heirs and Assigns forever, all that piece, parcel and lot of land just north of Travelers Rest, S. C. in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot number 82 of the Ray E. McAlister subdivision, and having according to a survey made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, revised January 1, 1952, and recorded in Plat Book EE & Pickell, Engineers, revised January 1, 1952, and recorded in Plat Book EE at pages 92-3, in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, the following metes and bounds to-wit:
