

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Fountain Inn, Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being Lots 5 and 6 on plat by J. W. & J. R. Crawford, Surveyor, September 12, 1956, recorded in the R. M. C.
