 CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION  
 BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

WILLIAM J. SWARTZ and PHYLLIS KISTNER SWARTZ

both of

University Student Homes, 1300 North Pleasantburg Dr., M.C. 140,  
 Greenville, South Carolina

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of

CHRIST-ROCK CAMP

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 30th day of

December, A. D. 1960, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is CHRIST-ROCK CAMP

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Route 2, LANDRUM, S. C. (Highway #11, near residence of Furman Pittman)

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to win youth to Christ and establish them on the Word of God teaching them that: whatever the Bible says is so. It is a true record of what God has said about Himself, about man and about the devil; proclaiming that Jesus Christ the Son of God, was born of a virgin, that He shed His blood on the cross to save by grace, all who will come to Him thru faith, that He rose bodily from the tomb and is coming again to receive His own.

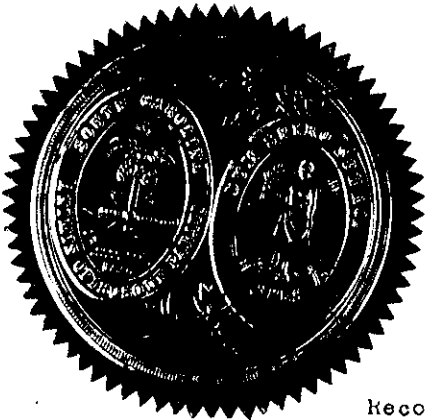
SIXTH: That they desire to be incorporated: In perpetuity.
