

or in equity against the person or persons violating, or attempting to violate, any such covenant, and either prevent him or them from so doing, or to recover damages or any other dues for such violation.

Invalidation of any of these covenants or restrictions by judgment or court order, shall in nowise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.

The final plat of lots numbered 1-124, inclusively, of this Subdivision shall be as prepared by R. K. Campbell, R.L.S., dated November 30, 1960, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book QQ at page 169, and shall be incorporated in by reference and made a part of these Protective Covenants and Restrictions.
