ALL of that lot of land in Greenville, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot # 18 of Broadmoor Subdivision, as shown by plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service dated July, 1960 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "RR" at page 47; said lot having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a pin at joint front corner of Lots # 17 and # 18 on the eastern side of Holmsby Lane and running thence with the eastern side of Holmsby Lane N. 17-03 W. 105 feet to a pin at the joint front corner of Lots # 18 and # 19; thence with the line of Lot # 19 N. 83-41 E. 160 feet to a pin in the rear line of Lot # 11; thence with the rear lines of Lots # 11 and # 12 S. 14-49 E. 90 feet to a pin at the rear of the corner of Lot # 17; thence with the line of Lot # 17 S. 78-28 W. 154.5 feet to the beginning corner.
