That I, W. Max Ward in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$5.00 and Love and Affection, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

PEARL W. KNIGHT, her heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with all buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one mile south from Batesville, lying on the Eastern side of the road that leads from Batesville to the Cross Roads Baptist Church, being shown and designated as LOT NO. 1 on Plat of property of John Ward Estate prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, February 20, 1947 and being bounded on the North by Lot No. 2 as shown on said plat; on the East and South by lands of Mrs. Gladys Christopher and on the West by the said road and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning on a nail and stopper in the center of the said road and being the joint corner of Mrs. Gladys Christopher's land and runs thence with the center of said road, North 9-26 East 325 feet to a nail and stopper in the center of said road, joint corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the dividing line of Lots 1 and 2, South 67-00 East 488 feet to a stake on branch; thence up the branch as the line, South 47-17 West 173 feet to a stake in the branch; thence continuing up the said branch, South 53-20 West 217 feet to a point in the said branch on the Northern edge of a farm road (stake on next line at 5 feet); thence with the Northern edge of the said farm road, North 61-38 West 233 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 2.91 acres, more or less, being the same property conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of Mrs. Hazel W. Poole, et al, recorded in Deed Book 591, at page 487, RMC Office for Greenville County.
