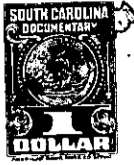

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Lewellen T. Hawkins, her heirs and assigns forever:

All our undivided right, title and interest in and to:

ALL that portion of ground in Graceland Cemetery, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, designated as graves 1, 2 and 3 of lot No. 188, Section 8, containing 100 square feet, more or less, as shown on plat of Graceland Cemetery, and on file in the office of the Greenville Cemetery Association, a corporation, subject to all the terms and conditions and restrictions contained in deed from said corporation to C. D. Speegle and W. H. McCauley, dated July 28th 1915, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 29 at page 272, and being a portion of the property conveyed by said grantees to A. I. Thompson by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office aforesaid in Deed Book 29 at page 306.

together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
