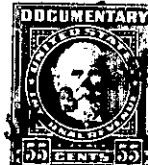

All our right, title, interest and estate in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being Lot No. 10 of Park Place, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
