WHEREAS, the parties of the second part under date of December 14, 1960, executed a lease to the Power Company and under date of January 17, 1961, executed a right of way agreement to the Power Company, which lease and right of way were executed to take the place of and in lieu of the above mentioned lease from Daniel Construction Company, Inc., to Duke Power Company;
