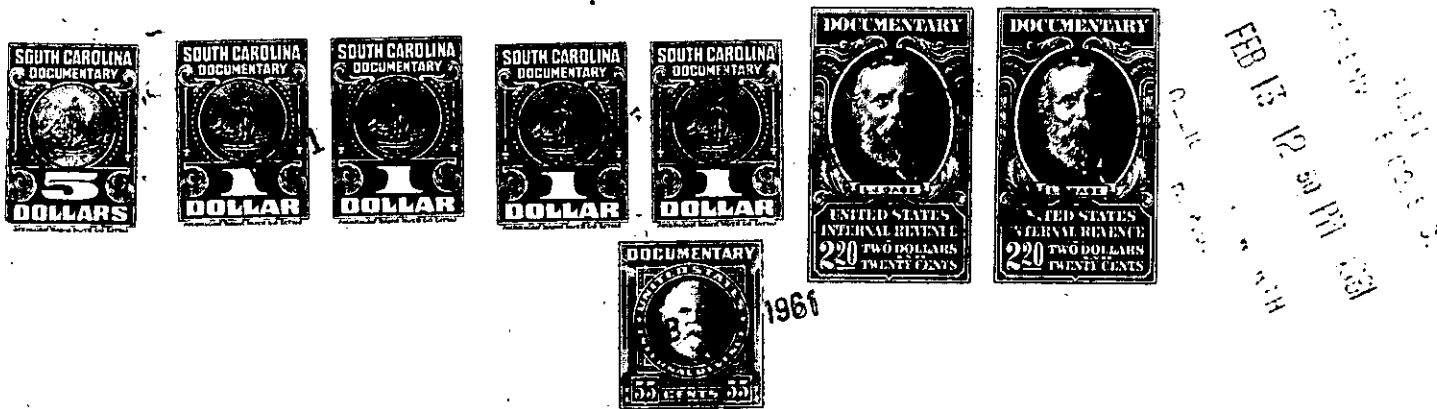
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME OR BE MADE KNOWN:
