BEGINNING on iron pin east side of new road, T. P. Stewart cor-
ner near big white oak; thence N. 30 1/2 E. 16.17 to a stone; thence S. 6 1/2 E. 18.54 to iron pin on south side of Glassy Mountain Road; thence S. 88 1/2 W. 1.56 chs. to a persimmon tree; thence N. 6-55 W. 6.27 to iron pin in field, new corner between Ben T. Boone and T. P. Stewart; thence S. 78 1/2 W. 8.40 to the beginning corner, and containing Six and 97/100 (6.97) acres, more or less, known as a part of the L. P.
