J. Gentry, thence with the Gentry line and line of J. H. Culbreth S. 9-15 E. 736 feet to a corner with the Plumley land, thence with line of the Plumley land and the Solesbee land N. 65-15 W. 2167 feet to an iron pin, which is 200 feet from the McClure corner, thence N. 1-35 E. 1570 feet to an iron pin under the power line to the Clark's Mountain house, thence N. 60-30 E. 1340 feet to an iron pin in a bridge on the Clark's Mountain private road, thence with the road N. 82-30 E. 135 feet and N. 15-45 W. 216 feet and N. 44-25 E. 114 feet and N. 79 E. 234 feet to an iron pin in the edge of the road, thence N. 45 E. 132 feet to the beginning corner.

This deed is made pursuant to Order of Hon. J. B. Pruitt, Presiding Judge of the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County in the case of Elford C. Morgan -vs- Rowena Morgan Mayson, which was filed in the office of Clerk of Court on January 6th, 1961, and grants and preserves to the parties respectively the rights as to roadway and power lines and other easements as directed in said Order and specified in the contract of division and partition executed by the parties September 3rd, 1958, which will be recorded herewith.
