Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of the S. S. Mason property at the northeast corner of the tract herein conveyed and runs thence S. 84-06 W., 575.3 feet along other property of the within grantor to a point in a road, iroin pin set off 21 feet on East bank; thence S. 6-15 E., 521.3 feet along the line of William S. Benson to an old iron pin, corner of Marie M. Strange property; thence S. 73-38 E., 484.2 feet along the line of the Strange property to an iron pin, corner of S. S. Mason property; thence N. 4-06 E., 717.1 feet along the line of the Mason property to the beginning corner and containing 7.33 acres more or less, and is a part of the same heretofore conveyed to the within grantor by Pearl Brown Stone by deed recorded in deed book 378 page 109, Greenville County R. ALSO:

The within grantor does hereby grant unto the within grantees, their heirs and assigns the exclusive right to use, but not to stop flow of a spring that is located about 200 feet North from the northern line of the property herein conveyed and about 200 feet west from the line of S. S. Mason property. The within grantees shall have the right to a 15 foot right of way to the spring from their property, and maintain a cattle lane to same, the right to install a pump, maintain same and use the spring as they see fit. The location of the said spring is shown on plat of property of George T. Brown Estate, made by H. S. Brockman, March 22, 1949, which plat is to be recorded herewith.
