AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, A.L. Beam by deed dated April 24, 1951, conveyed to Edward J. Jaskwhich and Dorothy C. Jaskwhich a tract of land containing 17 68/100ths acres, situate in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described in the said deed which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 433 at page 251, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid deed contained the following provision, "This property shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to anyone of African descent", and

WHEREAS, the undersigned are the current owners of all the property conveyed by the aforesaid deed, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to waive and release whatever right, if any, each may have to enforce the aforesaid provision.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100ths (\$1.00) Dollar, each to the other in hand paid (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) it is understood and agreed that the parties hereto do hereby release, relinquish and waive whatever rights they may have to that certain provision contained in the aforesaid deed from A.L. Beam to Edward J. Jaskwhich and Dorothy C. Jaskwhich, dated April 24, 1951, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 433 at page 251, which provision provides "This property shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed
