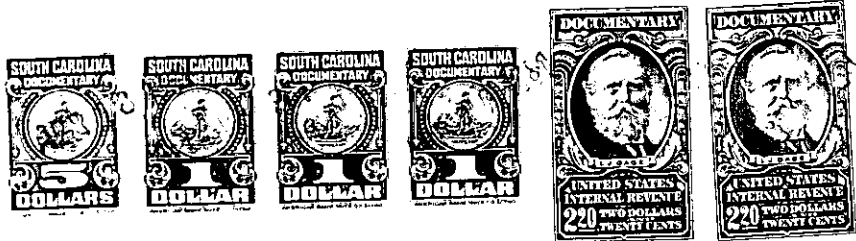

whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and
release unto GERALD H. DENTON AND JANELL B. DENTON:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate,
lying and being in or near Greenville; in the County of Greenville, South
Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 100, as shown on
plat entitled Subdivision for Abney Mills, Poinsett Plant, Greenville, South
Carolina, made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, March 5, 1959, and recorded
in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at page 51. Accord-
