RESOLUTION OF GREATER GREENVILLE SEWER  
DISTRICT COMMISSION PRESENTED AND ADOPTED  
THE ~~15TH~~ DAY OF ~~MAY~~, 1961  
8 TH MAY

WHEREAS, on or about November 15, 1960, Lanco, Inc., a corporation, and the owner of a tract of land located in Gantt Water and Sewer District immediately adjacent to the Greater Greenville Sewer District did petition the Greater Greenville Sewer District to annex and incorporate into the Greater Greenville Sewer District the following described tract of land:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, near the limits of the City of Greenville beginning at a point in the center of Jacob Road at corner of Dorothy Davis Miller and running thence along the line of Dorothy Davis Miller, N. 18-55 W. 1059.2 feet to an old iron pin; thence along the line of Richard Davis N. 23-46 E. 982.19 feet to an old iron pin on the Frank Earle line; thence along the line of Frank Earle, N. 71-39 E. 567.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 37-40 E. 155 feet along the line of Pleasant Valley to an iron pin; thence S. 58-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 72-20 E. 487.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 26-45 E. 330 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 39-00 E. 330 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16-00 E. 610.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 4-00 E. 561.0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-30 E. 470.8 feet to a point in Jacob Road (Prosperity Avenue); thence S. 6-47 W. 133 feet to a point on the South side of Jacob Road; thence S. 77-53 W. 157 feet crossing a bridge to a point still in Jacob Road; thence still with Jacob Road, N. 86-54 W. 266 feet; thence N. 81-21 W. 374 feet to a point still in Jacob Road; thence N. 71-05 W. 228 feet to a point in Jacob Road; thence N. 57-24 W. to a point still in Jacob Road; thence along Jacob Road, N. 66-13 W. 100 feet to a point in Jacob Road; thence still along Jacob Road N. 60-48 W. 324.7 feet; thence still with Jacob Road, N. 74-08 W. 257 feet to the point of beginning, being the same property conveyed to Lanco, Inc., by deed of Estelle Cureton

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
