KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, J. S. Paget, in the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and other good and valuable consideration to the Grantor in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), and in accordance with the Living Trust Indenture by and between J. S. Paget, Grantor and Ruth C. Paget, as Trustee, dated May ______, 1961, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said Ruth C. Paget, as Trustee, the following property:

ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 8-GD, now within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the North side of Cureton Street, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. Street, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 4 and 5 on plat of the property of the Estate of J. A. Davenport made in December, 1924, by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and having, in the aggregate, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
