CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS,

HENRY L. TAYLOR, 226 Pleasant Ridge Ave., Greenville, S. C.

and

MILTON TAYLOR, 36 Beck Avenue, Greenville, S. C.

did on the 23rd day of June, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is MOJAY ENTERPRISES, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 226 Pleasant Ridge Avenue, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to publish sheet music, greeting cards and phonographic recordings; to operate a booking agency, and to perform any and all other acts incident thereto.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00)-----Dollars payable in cash and services

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of Fifty (\$50.00)-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 20th day of June, 1961, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Milton H. Taylor, Paul Cox, Henry L. Taylor, Johnny Cox and Jackie Pearson

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Henry L. Taylor; as Vice-President, Jackie Pearson; as Secretary, Johnny Cox; as Treasurer, Paul Cox

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greer Citizen

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesue Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
