

ALSO: Lot No. 8 on Plat of property of the Estate of Clarence Goldsmith. made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, June, 1929, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 148, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a point on Hammett Road at the joint corners of Lots Nos. 7 and 8 and running thence along Lot No. 7, S. 40-43 E. 110 Feet to the corner of Lot No. 15; thence along the line of Lot No. 15, N. 49-17 E. 45 feet to the corner of Lot No. 9; thence along the line of Lot No. 9, N. 40-43 W. 110 feet to Hammett Road; thence along Hammett Road, S. 49-17 W. 45 feet to the beginning corner.
