Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, WILLIAM B. DUCKER in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred (\$12,500.00) DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JOHN C. SMITH, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of LeGrand Boulevard, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 5 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1951, revised through November 1952, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", at pages 2 and 3 (also recorded in Plat Book EE, pages 30 and 31), and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of LeGrand Boulevard, at joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5, and running thence with the line of Lot 4, N. 88-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-30 W. 73 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 6, S. 88-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the East side of LeGrand Boulevard; thence with the East side of LeGrand Boulevard, S. 1-30 E. 73 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

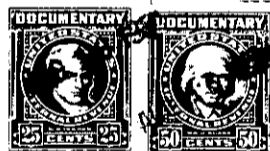
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.
