Know All Men by These Presents:

That LEWIS P. YORK in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Four And 48/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. LOUIS COWARD CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate at the Northeast intersection of Edwards Road and Ike's Road, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No: 3 on plat of property of James F. Finley, made by J. Mac Richardson, May, 1959, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "SS", page 165, and having according to said plat and a survey by R. K. Campbell, dated January 12, 1960, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Edwards Road, at joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3, and runs thence with the line of Lot 2, S. 52-35 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 4, S. 21-30 W. 50.1 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Ike's Road; thence along the North side of Ike's Road, S. 88-27 W. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Ike's Road and Edwards Road (the chord being N. 30-05 W. 19.1 feet) to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Edwards Road; thence along Edwards Road, N. 31-24 E. 54.8 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Edwards Road, N. 37-04 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

The Grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on that mortgage given by Lewis P. York to The Prudential Life Insurance Company of America on January 19, 1960, original amount of \$12,500.00, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Mortgage Book 814 at Page 193, on which there remains a balance due of \$12,159.42.
