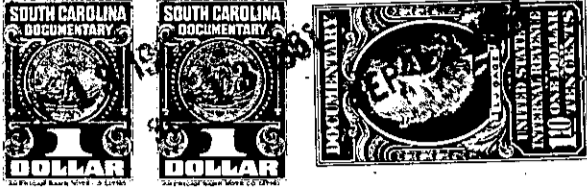

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Ernest M. Vaughn

to Ernest M. Vaughn in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Billy C. McKee and Jean Mullinax McKee  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Billy C. McKee and Jean Mullinax McKee

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, about two miles northeast of Taylors, S. C.  
and lying on the south side of a County surface treated road, shown  
and designated as lots 9 and 10 on a plat of the R. L. Wynn Estate,  
plat made by J. Q. Bruce March 18, 1950, said plat to be recorded  
in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following  
courses and distances, to wit:--

COMMENCING at a point on said surface treated road and running thence  
S 5-34 W 200 feet to a stake; thence S 84-26 E 200 feet to a stake;  
thence N 5-34 E 200 feet to a stake; thence N 84-26 W 200 feet to  
the point of commencement.
