CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, W. H. WILSON, CLARICE T. WILSON, MARJORIE W. LIGON, G. L. STRATTON
all of
Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 26th day of October, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is WILSON DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 624 Bramlett Road, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to engage in the business generally of owning, developing, purchasing, selling, trading or exchanging real estate and personal property and to lend, to borrow funds for the financing, mortgaging, managing and leasing of the same.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00)---Dollars payable by the conveyance of real estate of a value in excess of \$500,000.00, the deed of conveyance having been executed by the owners, three of whom are the Declarants in this application

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Ten Thousand (10,000) of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) per share-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 25th day of October, 1961, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: W. H. Wilson, Clarice T. Wilson, Marjorie W. Ligon and G. L. Stratton

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, W. H. Wilson ;
Vice President, Marjorie W. Ligon ;
as Vice-President, Clarice T. Wilson ; as Secretary, G. L. Stratton ;
as Treasurer, G. L. Stratton

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
