

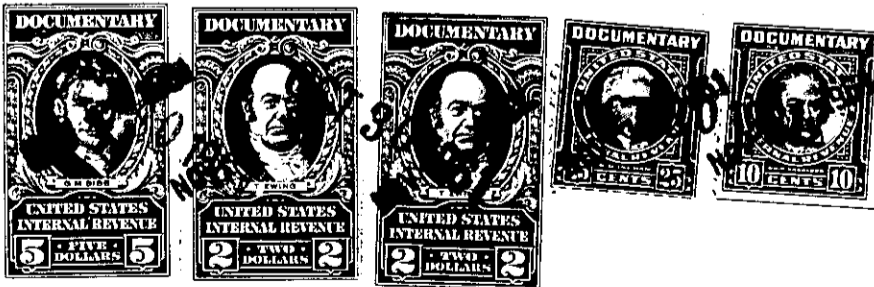
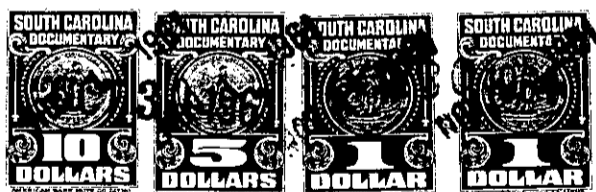
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that NEW YORK LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in
 the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as
 Lots Nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5 and a portion of Lot No. 1 on Block B of Stone Estates
 made by C. M. Furman, Jr., dated October, 1931, and recorded in the R.M.C.
 Office for Greenville County in Plat Book G at page 292 and having according
 to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the western side of Druid Street, which iron pin
 is situate 131.4 feet north of the intersection of Druid Street and Northwood
 Avenue and running thence on a line through Lot No. 1, N. 81-35 W., 108.3 feet
 to an iron pin; thence N. 56-04 W., 37.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 23-20 W.,
 11.3 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear of Lots Nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5, N.
 11-22 E., 83.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear of Lot No. 6; thence with the line
 of Lot No. 6, S. 81-35 E., 150 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Druid
 Street; thence with said street, S. 11-22 W., 110 feet to the point of beginning.
