CHRISTOPHER, HER HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, FOREVER, all of our right, title and interest in and to:

" All that piece, parcel or lot of alnd with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in or near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot 128, Section B, as shown on a plat entitled "A Subdivision for Woodside Mills, Greenville, S.
