the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Lloyd W. Gilstrap, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the southeast side of Fairtruck Road, in the city of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as lot 64 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1951, revised through November 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in plat book GG, pages 70 & 71 (Also recorded in plat book BB, pages 30 and 31) and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Fairtruck road at joint front corner of lots 63 and 64 and running thence along the line of lot 63, S. 48-56, 140 feet to iron pin; thence S. 20-48E, 30 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of lots 65, N 87-17 W 181.6 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Fairtruck Road; thence with the curve of Fairtruck Road (the chord being N 30-21 E., 129 feet) to the beginning corner.
