That this power as herein bestowed shall become effective on the date of execution of this instrument and shall remain in full force and effect during the remainder of my natural life.

I do also hereby confirm and affirm all of the acts and deeds and executions of the said William M. Thompson while acting in my name and stead under the terms and conditions of this Power of Attorney and by ratifying all of his acts, I do hereby bind myself to all terms, conditions and obligations as executed by him in accordance with this authority.

In the event that William M. Thompson departs this life or fails to qualify for any reason to carry out the above power, I do name and substitute my brother, J. Claude Thompson with same power and authorities as hereinabove vested in William M. Thompson.
