SUPPLEMENTAL RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That

WHEREAS, by Right of Way Agreement dated November 9, 1949, recorded in Deed Book 396, page 335, of the Deed records of Greenville County, South Carolina, Nan Martin Hoffmann (Now Nan Martin Hopkins), hereinafter called Grantor, conveyed to Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation, its successors and assigns, hereinafter called Grantee, a right of way and easement for pipe line purposes across the lands described therein situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, reference being here made to said right of way agreement for a complete description of the lands involved and for all other purposes, and

WHEREAS, Grantee has heretofore constructed three pipe lines across said lands in accordance with the provisions of said right of way agreement and may in the future, from time to time, desire to construct additional pipe lines pursuant thereto, and Grantor has requested Grantee to enter into this agreement for the purpose of defining Grantee's right of way and further clarifying the relative rights and obligations of the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between Grantee and Grantor that said right of way agreement dated November 9, 1949, shall be and is hereby modified, supplemented and amended as follows:

(1) Grantee's permanent right of way shall be the strip or area shaded and identified as "R/W area" and delineated by metes and bounds on Drawing No. G-1381, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof. Grantee shall have the right, during the construction of one additional pipe line, to clear and use the additional strip of land 35 feet in width adjoining the southeasterly boundary of said permanent right of way and hatched and identified as "35' temporary work space" on the drawing attached
