All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, On the west side of U. S. Highway No. 29, and being known and designated as Lot No. 91 of the T. D. Bennett Sub-division, as shown by plat made by G. Sam Lowe, Registered C. E., dated August 24, 1948, and recorded in the Greenville County R.M.C. Office in plat Book S, page 143, and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north side of Cemetery Street 200 feet west from U. S. Highway No. 29 and running thence N. 25°-25' E. 300 feet to a corner; thence N. 61°-05' W. 50 feet to the joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 90 and 91; thence S. 22°-10' W. 318 feet to a corner in the north edge of Cemetery Street; thence with the north edge of Cemetery Street S. 85°-30' E. 38 feet to the beginning corner.

Located on this lot of land is a small cemetery known as the Bennett Cemetery, but most of those buried there have the name of Waddel. This property is conveyed for the use of the Cemetery for ever and to be used for no other purpose.
