to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Cora Richardson, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 1 on a subdivision and Plat of City View Annex made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Eng., on June 10, 1925, and now of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at Page 15, and described by courses and distances as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the North side of Fourth Street, at joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence along the line of said Fourth Street, 50 feet; thence N. 9-20 E. 178.1 feet; thence N. 78-18 E. 71 feet to joint rear line of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the line of Lot No. 2 a distance of 208 feet to the beginning point on Fourth Street.

Being the same property conveyed to the Grantor by Cora Richardson by deed recorded in Deed Book 603, Page 193, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the Grantee assumes and agrees to pay the balance due on Mortgage executed to Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Assn. in the original amount of \$1,000.00. recorded in Mortgage Book 687, at page 302, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

The Grantee agrees to pay 1962 taxes.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
