CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

T. B. Henry, 218 Azalea Court, Greenville, S. C.

and

Clifton Jordan, Jr., 29 Brunson Street, Greenville, S. C.

did on the 31st day of July, 1962, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is PRECISION AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION SERVICE, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 912 Anderson Road, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is operate a general garage at both wholesale and retail and to do all other things which a corporation in South Carolina is legally entitled to do.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars payable One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars in cash and equipment

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Two Hundred (200) shares of the par value of Ten (\$10.00) per share Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 30th day of July, 1962, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: T. B. Henry, Clifton Jordan, Jr.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, T. B. Henry; as Vice-President, Clifton Jordan, Jr.; as Secretary, Clifton Jordan, Jr.; as Treasurer, T. B. Henry

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greer Citizen

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
