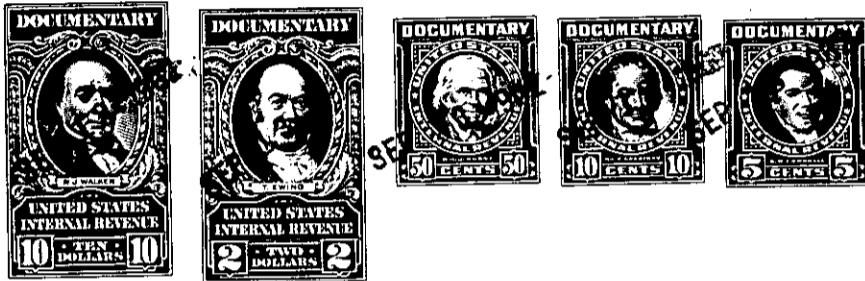

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That William C. Henderson and Sue A. Henderson

in the State aforesaid Greenville County in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand five hundred (\$ 11,500) Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by George G. Crump and Annie Sue Crump

in the State aforesaid Greenville County

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said. George G. Crump and Annie Sue Crump, their heirs and assigns, the following described property to wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and designated as lots No. 6 and on a plat subdividing the real estate of J.T. Flynn Estate west of the town of Taylors, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the West Side of the Reid School Road, common corners of Lots No. 5 and 6, and running thence S. 85-11 W. 330 feet to an iron pin, common corners of lots 1 and 6; thence N. 2-30 W. 197 feet to an iron pin, common corners of Lots No. 7 and 8; thence N. 87- 30 E. 317 feet to an iron pin on the west side of the Reid School Road, Common Corners of lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence with the west side of Reid School Road, S. 5-55 E. 100.8 feet, and bounded on the north by lot no. 8, and on the east by The Reid School Road, and on the south by lots 1 and 5 inclusive. Being the same property conveyed by Wyatt Y McDaniel, Jr. and Alucia C. McDaniel by their deed dated August 2 1949 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 388 at Page 21
