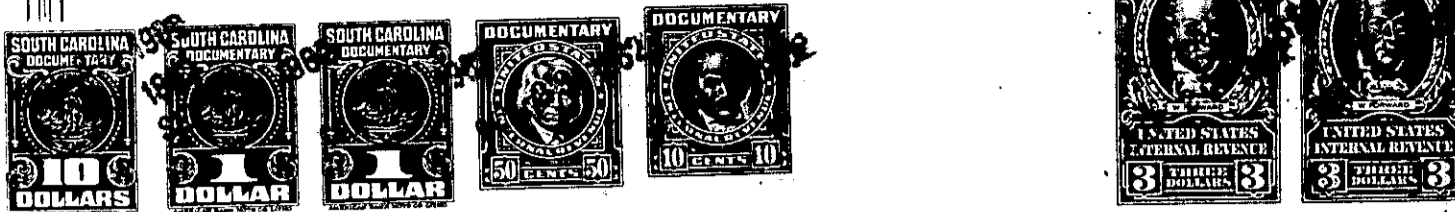

to Beauford Wood & Lola B. Wood in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Hazel Edwards

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Hazel C Edwards

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina near the mush creek baptist church, bounded by lands John Evett, M.M.Thompson, Ben Sentell and John Burns, Located on an improved road that leads by the old Boswell place, containing Eight (8) acres, more or less and having the following courses and distances:

BEGGINNING on an iron pin on said road that leads by the old Boswell place, and runs thence S. 89 W. 1069.2 feet to an iron pin near a branch; thence N. 1.00 W. 257. 5 feet to an iron pin near a willow the old Boswell corner; thence with the Boswell line 145 feet, more or less, to an old corner; thence N. 88. 45 E. 825 feet to a point in the above mentioned road; thence with the road as the line south 45.30 E. 396 feet to a bend in said road; thence S. 20 E. 136 feet to the beginning corner, and being a portion of that ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ tract of land conveyed to the grantor by S.E. Mitchell, by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in deed book 475, at page 551.
