RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 19th day of September, 1962, by and between T. L. PUTMAN ESTATE; INEZ G. PUTMAN, WIDOW, J. W. PUTMAN AND WIFE, VIRGINIA M. PUTMAN, ALICE PUTMAN CAIN AND HUSBAND, E. H. CAIN, T. E. PUTMAN AND WIFE, CONNIE M. PUTMAN,

hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey corporation, hereinafter called "Grantee";

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of \$ 1,900.00 ... paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described strip of those certain lands which are situate in Greenville County, South Carolina, and are described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Pollard's line and running thence S 14 1/2 W 18.30 to a stone; thence N 42 1/2 W 9.00 to stone; thence N 20-1/2 W 7.30 to stone; thence N 17 1/4 W 4.47 to stone; thence S 89 1/2 E 14.82 to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to Grantor by deed of George P. Wenck dated November 23, 1942 and recorded in Book 249 at page 186 in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County.
