KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, Eugene Rackley and Elizabeth M. Rackley

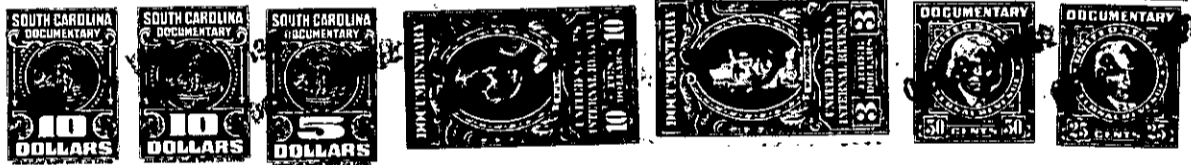
in consideration of Six Thousand Six Hundred (\$6,600.00)----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto L. N. Ridlehoover and Willie Jo T. Ridlehoover, their heirs and assigns:

All that peice, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southern side of Cottingham Street near Monaghan Mills, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 55 as shown on a plat entitled "Monaghan Subdivision, Greenville, S. C." made by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S.C., August 9, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at pages 86 and 87, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Cottingham Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 54 and 55 and running thence with the line of Lots Nos. 54 and 53, S. 79-06 E. 214 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 53 at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 55 and 56; thence with the line of Lot No. 56, N. 13-28 W. 156.9 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Cottingham Street; thence with the Southern side of Cottingham Street, S. 76-32 W. 85.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Cottingham Street, the chord of which is S. 44-31 W. 129.4 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Monaghan Subdivision recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 509 at page 443, and to an easement for utilities service dated October 11, 1954, given by J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. to Duke Power Company and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 510 at page 317.
