to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents THE COUNTY OF GREENVILLE, (A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION EXISTING UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, ITS SUCCESSORS & ASSIGNS)

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said COUNTY OF GREENVILLE, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION EXISTING UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER:

ALL that parcel or strip of land near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being all the land embraced within the street or road shown as Terramont Circle and runs from the North side of a County Road and extends in a North and Northeasterly direction to the Southeast side of old Spartanburg Road as shown on a plat of Terra Pines estates made by Piedmont Engineering Service, December 1958, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book RR, page 31, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Said strip of land being 50 feet in width throughout its entire length.

This strip of land is conveyed to the Grantee to be used for a street or road purposes.

A Revision of the above mentioned plat made Nov. 1961 is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County S.C. in Plat Book "RR" at pages 96 and 97.
