

d. No assets other than those transferred, conveyed or paid in accordance with paragraphs a and b above shall be transferred or conveyed to any individual, member, officer or director.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that the Secretary of State do issue to The Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of Greenville, South Carolina, Inc., a Certificate of Incorporation, with all rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities conferred by Chapter 12, Title 12, 1952, and Acts amendatory thereto.
